

Summary:

1. Legend displaying "Value" and "Label"

What did it do?

The legend displayed the "Label" field even if it was not populated (*Please see Image A*).

What is the new outcome?

Now, if the "Label" field is blank, there will no longer be a "Value" column in your legend. In this scenario, data that is in the "Value" field will be migrated over to the "Label" field (*Please see Image B*).

Summary:

2. Double Layer Styling Dialog Box

What did it do?

When you selected a layer from the Layer Control Menu, and opened the "Styling" dialog box, it was possible to click on a separate layer, and have a second "Styling" dialog box appear (causing confusion around what layer you were modifying) (*Please see Image A*).

What is the new outcome?

Changes have been made to the UI so only one styling interface can be opened at a time (*Please see Image B*).




Image A: Two dialog boxes displayed at the same time




Image B: After fixes; one dialog box displays

3. Thematics Dialog Pointing to Wrong Layer

What did it do?

Sometimes, when opening the "Thematics" dialog box, it would not point to the selected layer (*Please see Image A*).

Now, the "Thematics" dialog box will always point to the selected layer (Please see Image B).




Image A: Dialog box not pointing to selected layer
